

New Haven Cross Country Invitational

The New Haven Cross Country Invitational will be held on Saturday, September 2, 2023 at 8:30 a.m. in the New Haven City Park, which is adjacent to the high school.

Bus parking is available at Lions Field. Please enter the park by Roy Bail Park. Tent City will be in the Lions Field outfield. Spots will not be marked.

Rest Rooms are located on the park grounds. There will be a concession stand available that will sell drinks. T-shirts will be available for purchase. Spectators can park in the school parking lot or in the swimming pool parking lot.

The coaches meeting will take place at 8:15 a.m. at the scoring pavilion.

Water will not be provided. Please come prepared.

The junior high school girls race begins at 8:30 a.m. The order will be junior high girls, junior high boys, JV girls, JV boys, varsity girls, and varsity boys. The open race will take place after the varsity boys' race. The race is open to any coaches, fans, or community members who would like to run the course.

The awards will be given out to coaches in envelopes after the conclusion of the last race. In each of the junior high races, 1 team plaque and 10 medals will be given. In each of the high school races, 1 team plaque and 15 medals will be given. There is a limit of 7 runners per school in the varsity races. In the lower level races, there is not a limit on the number of runners entered.

All entries will be made on MoMileSplit. Deadline for entries is Wednesday, August 30 at 6:00 p.m. After this time, entries will not be accepted.

The entry fee is \$25.00 per high school division and \$20.00 per middle school division. (\$100 maximum)
